

Overview: Brimfield Township, 22 ½ square miles in size with approximately 15,000 residents, is strategically located in Southwest Portage County. The township has access to an excellent transportation system with 2 interstate highway exchanges on I-76, State Route 43 traversing north/south through the township, and State Route 261 located just north of the township. Ongoing residential growth has developed the community and made Brimfield one of the fastest growing Townships in Ohio. The township is home to Newell Rubbermaid and the headquarters of Carter Lumber, coupled with a significant retail presence at *The Cascades of Brimfield* and *The Marketplace at Maplecrest*. With Kent State University on our border, easy accessibility puts Brimfield within one hour's drive of Cleveland, Akron, Canton or Youngstown, and a quiet drive in the country is literally only minutes away.

Police Department: The Police Department provides one of the most indispensable functions to our community - professional police services. The Department is currently allotted 20 Officers. The Department also has 3 Administrative Assistants, as well as non-sworn Auxiliary personnel to assist our staff. With computer aided dispatch (CAD) provided by Kent State University PD, a cruiser fleet equipped with in-car wireless video systems, mobile wireless laptop computers and body cameras, and a UAV program, our Department strives to incorporate better technology to make the job of public safety more efficient. The *backbone* of the Department is our personnel – serving our Brimfield community with integrity.

Major Duties – Police Officers: Handling calls for service, interacting with the community and community relations, patrolling to deter and detect crime, investigating complaints, citing and arresting law violators, protecting people and property, securing prisoners, preparing written reports, use of computers, and testifying in court. The Brimfield Police Department also provides opportunities to progress to assignments as organizational needs arise, such as Metro SWAT, Portage County Drug Task Force, DARE, School Resource Officer (SRO), K-9, Investigations, Crisis Intervention (CIT), Training Instructor, Field

Training Officer (FTO) and Crime Prevention Specialist (CPS). All Officers are provided with training opportunities to serve the department and to further their career development.

Position Openings will be posted at www.brimfieldpolice.com and via agency social media platforms. Applicants must possess a high school diploma or GED, valid Ohio driver's license, have no felony convictions, and possess a current Ohio Peace Officer Training Certification, or currently be enrolled in a police academy. A copy of high school/college diplomas, military veteran DD-214's and Ohio Peace Officer Certificates must be submitted with the application.

Candidates Selected: Must successfully pass a written examination taken at a local testing center or virtually from home through National Testing Network (<https://www.nationaltestingnetwork.com/publicsafetyjobs/index.cfm>), physical agility testing, interviews, background check, polygraph test, physical and psychological exams, drug test, and have corrected vision of 20/20. There is a one year probationary period. There are no residency restrictions. Lateral candidates selected are credited for vacation and compensation based on their prior service time.
